Churchill Park Academy: Provider Access Policy

This policy statement sets out the school's arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them information about the provider's education or training offer. This complies with the school's legal obligations under Section 42B of the Education Act 1997 (the Baker Clause).

Pupil entitlement students in years 7-14, are entitled:

- To access a careers programme which provides information on the full range of education and training options available at transition.
- To hear from a range of local providers about the opportunities they offer through visitors, events and Enterprise Encounters days.
- From year 9, to have transition information completed on their EHCP.

Opportunities for access

Events such as workshops and Enterprise Encounter days, will offer providers an opportunity to come into school to speak to pupils and/or their parents/carers. Students will be able to access enterprise activities and have opportunities to gain skills in work related learning.
